Among our achievements, we have:

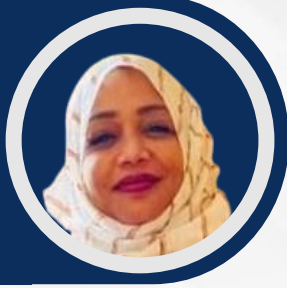
- Successfully implemented 40 critical projects, totaling 11 million U.S. dollars.

Through central kitchens, seasonal distributions—including Ramadan, Zakat Al Fitr, and Eid Udhia/Qurbani—and emergency relief efforts, Sadagaat remains committed to providing lifesaving support, addressing food insecurity, and assisting those most in need.

Sadagaat Charity Organization is committed to addressing these urgent issues by enhancing water infrastructure, expanding sanitation services, and delivering essential WASH interventions in vulnerable regions. Through the construction of water wells, the rehabilitation of water stations, and timely emergency response efforts, Sadagaat ensures that communities, including displaced populations, have adequate and dependable access to safe drinking water and necessary sanitation services, thereby significantly improving their quality of life.

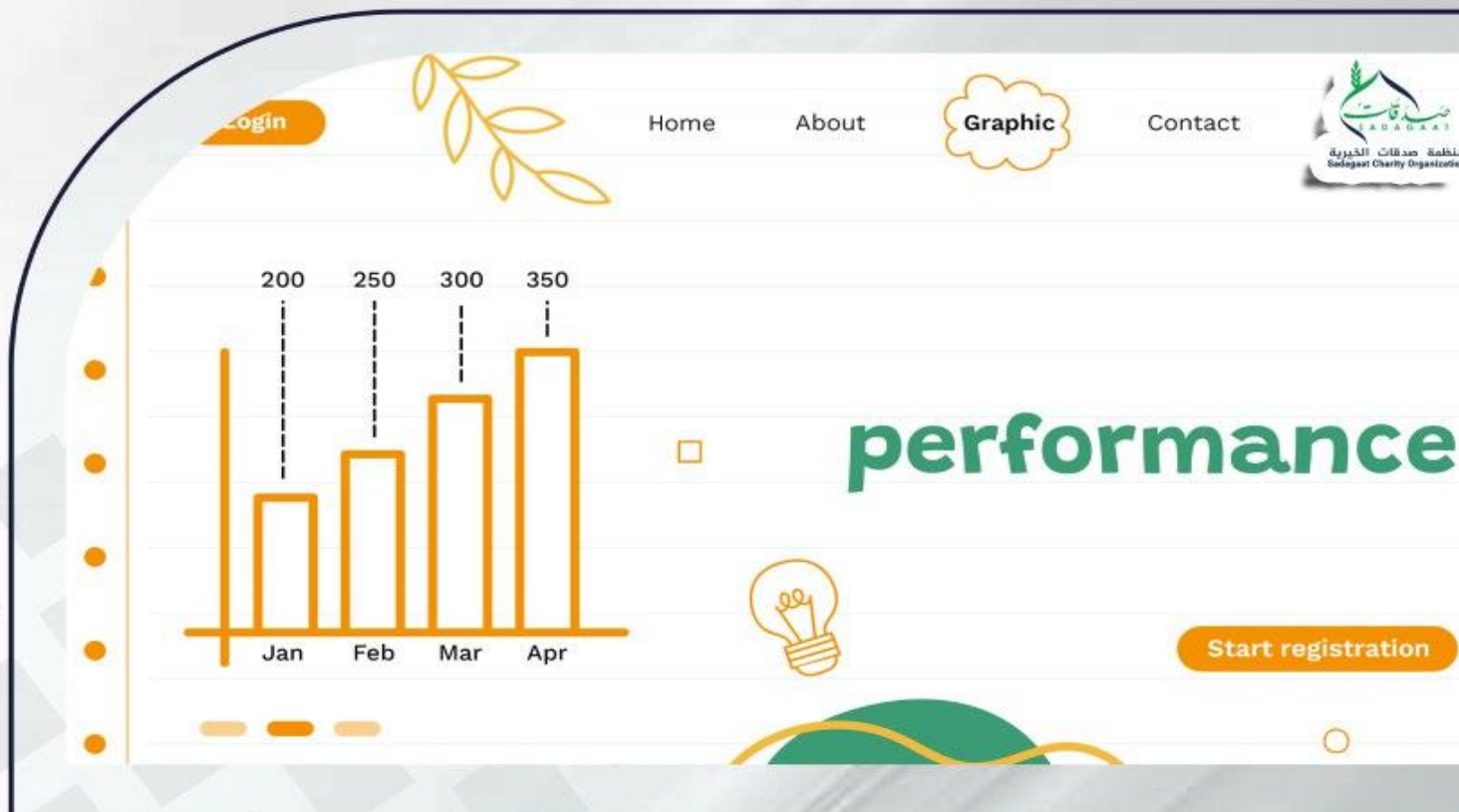

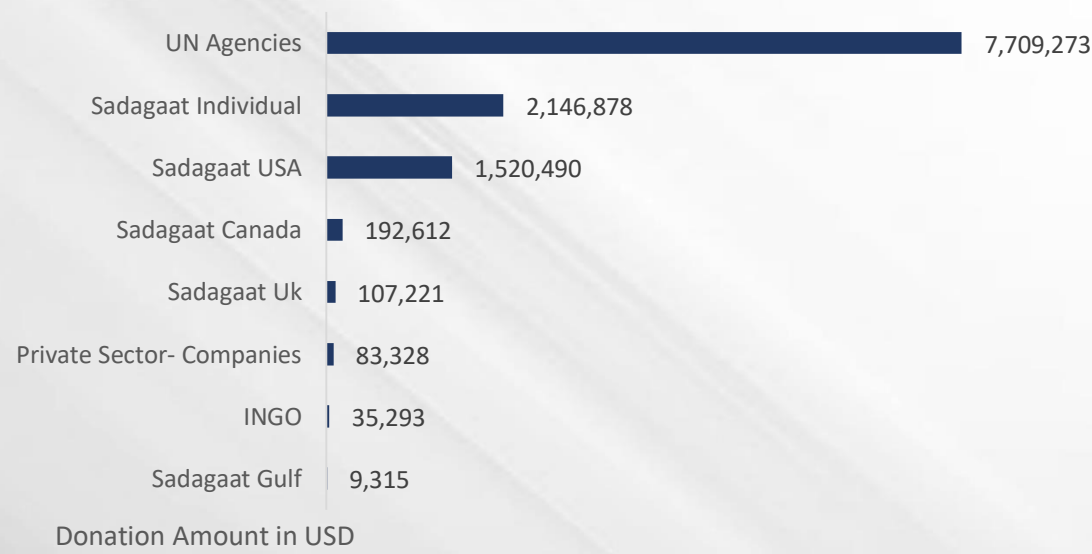

Comparison of Organization Budget in USD:

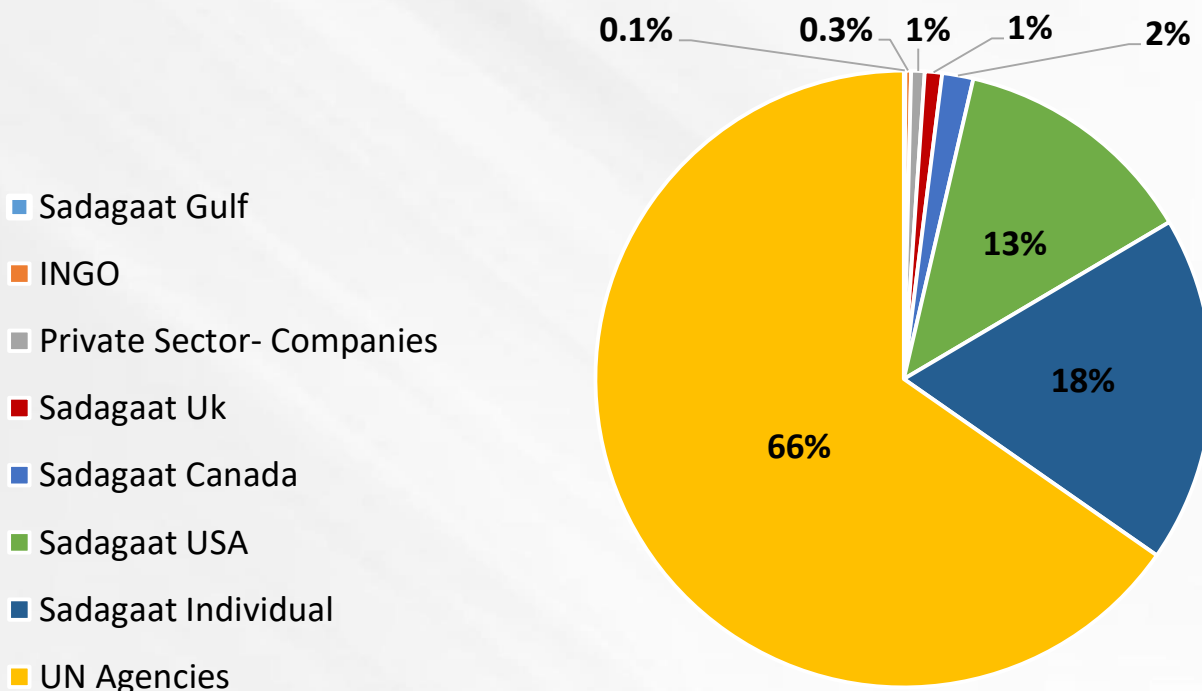


Revenue 2024:

Expansion of Partnerships and Revenue Growth in 2024

The 2024 revenue report showcases significant growth in Sadagaat's partnerships, especially with UN agencies, which accounted for 66% of the total funding, amounting to \$7.7 million. Despite the challenging economic situation, Sadagaat's individual donors—who have always been at the heart of the organization—demonstrated remarkable generosity. Their contributions surged by 534% compared to the previous year, rising from \$300K to \$2.2 million, reaffirming the vital role of community-driven support in sustaining Sadagaat's humanitarian efforts. This year witnessed a substantial rise in institutional funding, largely fueled by new partnerships with the World Food Program (WFP) and the United Nations Development Program (UNDP), particularly in food security and development initiatives. Additionally, Sadagaat's collaboration with the International Organization for Migration (IOM) through the Rapid Response Fund (RRF) and the Common Pipeline significantly enhanced its emergency response capacity, strengthening WASH interventions for displaced communities across five states in Sudan.

The Sudanese diaspora continues to serve as a crucial pillar of Sadagaat's funding model, with individual donations accounting for 18% of the total revenue (approximately \$2.1 million), while Sadagaat USA contributed 13% (around \$1.52 million). These contributions reflect a growing global solidarity and an increasing confidence in Sadagaat's ability to deliver effective humanitarian aid, especially during periods of heightened vulnerability and crisis. Additionally, support from private sector partnerships and international NGOs has been instrumental in ensuring that Sadagaat maintains a sustainable, diversified approach to humanitarian response.

Sadagaat's overall budget in 2024 more than tripled compared to previous years, reaching \$10.95 million. This growth highlights the organization's strengthened capacity to execute large-scale interventions and its agility in responding to the evolving humanitarian challenges in Sudan. Moving forward, we are committed to sustaining and expanding these partnerships to ensure a long-term, impact-driven approach to crisis response and development.



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
